Gateway SSH server

CCCF is in the process of enhancement of the network security in view of the multiple attempts of cyber-attacks in the recent past to many servers in the TIFR network which are open to the Internet. Considering the frequency and the depth of the attacks, all TIFR servers will be brought behind the central secure gateway firewall. This will come into effect from 31 July 2019.

For the convenience of the users, in addition to the existing stable SSL VPN setup, CCCF has setup one more gateway SSH server named gwssh.tifr.res.in running on port 4748 as central SSH tunnel for transactions into and out of TIFR server. This server will be LDAP enabled and kept on high security standards and will be under the constant vigil of CCCF and actively monitored.
