

How to connect eduroam in Linux Operating System

1. Make sure that wireless button on your device is turned on.
2. Browse for wireless network named “**eduroam**” and click on it.
3. A dialog box will appear asking “**Authentication required by Wi-Fi network**”.
4. Enter the following information in the Wireless Network you want to connect.

- Wireless Security: **WPA & WPA2 Enterprise.**
- Authentication: **Protected EAP(PEAP).**
- Inner authentication: **MSCHAPv2.**
- Username: username@tifr.res.in .
- Password: **your_LDAP_password.**

5. Rest all settings remains the same. Click on Connect button to connect to the wireless network.
6. A dialog box will appear “**No Certificate Authority certificate chosen**”. Tick mark on “Don’t warn me again” and click on Ignore button to get connected to the network.
