

## How to get connected to “Hostel” wireless network on Android

### Operating System

**Note:** Only TIFR hostel residents residing in Brahmagupta and Patanjali are permitted to use the wireless network. Devices used for wireless internet access in the hostel must be registered through Service Request System ([SRS](#)).

### Operating System Compatibility

- Gingerbread version 2.3
- Honeycomb version 3.0
- Ice Cream Sandwich version 4.0
- Jelly Bean version 4.1
- Kitkat version 4.4
- Lollipop version 5.0
- Marshmallow version 6.0
- Nougat version 7.0 [\*]
- Oreo version 8.0 [\*]
- Pie version 9.0 [\*]

Tested on above flavors of Android. May work on other flavors of Android also, users can make an attempt.

1. Make sure that wireless button on your device is turned on.
2. Browse for wireless network named “**Hostel**” on your device and click on it.
3. [\*] Select "Do not validate" for CA certificate. [*Perform this step from Nougat version onwards*"]
4. Enter the following information in the Wireless Network you want to connect.
  - Identity: your LDAP/mailhost username.
  - Password: your LDAP/mailhost password.
5. Rest all settings remain the same. Click on Connect button to connect to the wireless network.
