Goa has a warm, tropical climate with an average temperature of 21°C (79°F) throughout the year. The winter months December to February, are delightfully cool and sunny, and from June to September, Goa is drenched by the south west monsoon which turns the countryside into a lush garden. The land is covered with paddy fields and groves of cashew, mango and coconut. Strung along the 100 km. coastline are golden stretches of beaches with picturesque names like Arambol, Vagator, Baga, Anjuna, Calangute in the north, and the raw beauty of Colva, Betul and Palolthe South.

DAY 2	Goa	Breakfast at the hotel Late Morning Proceed for half day tour of Old Goa
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Visit the **Basilica of Bom Jesus** which houses the mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier kept in a rich casket, and the **Se Cathedral**, (1510) a towering white structure with a grand baroque interior. It is the most imposing of all churches at Old Goa. Its vaulted interior with the insignia of the King of Portugal, 14 gold embossed altars and Doric arches overwhelms the visitor by sheer grandeur. The Cathedral has five bells of which one is the famous Golden Bell, the biggest in Goa and one of the best in the world. It is dedicated to St. Catherine who was martyred for preferring the convent to a king. The last stop is the Mangeshri Temple.
