

### **Thesis: First submission for sending to examiners:**

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#### Format of the thesis:

- a) The thesis must contain the "cover page" and the "declaration" page both of which are available for download on the forms link <http://www.tifr.res.in/~gsoffice/FORMS.htm>
- b) **Do not** include your synopsis in your thesis
- c) It is **necessary** to write a thoughtful introduction that could serve as a "*Trends...*" level review for your area. It is encouraged that the student and Adviser should work to submit such a first-author review to an appropriate journal.
- d) It is perfectly **acceptable** to include your published papers in the journal's .pdf format as chapters in your thesis if your Adviser permits you to do so. Typically, first authors and substantially contributing second authors are encouraged to include their published papers in the journal's .pdf format (so as not to waste paper printing in .doc format), while other contributors should use the figures/data they contributed in chapters as they see fit.

A hard copy "thesis submission form (the back of which contains a new checklist for thesis submission)" is also available on this link and needs to be submitted to Univ Cell in hard copy after printing back-to-back and getting your Adviser's signature on both sides. Univ Cell will forward it to SBB Convener.
