Regular scientific sessions will include invited lectures, oral presentations from selected abstracts and poster presentation.

Professor G.N. Ramachandran lecture will be delivered by Prof. S. Ogawa, discoverer of "BOLD" phenomenon which is the basis of functional MRI.

#### Poster Awards/Travel Grants

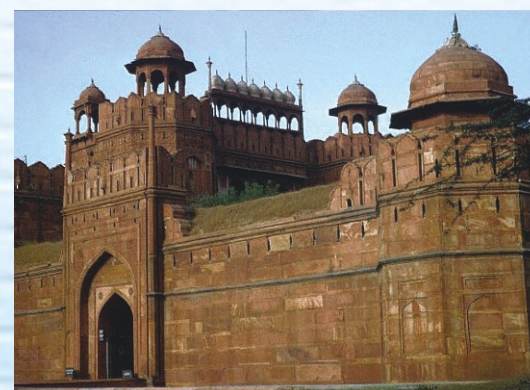
