

## **Agreement of confidentiality**

TIFR encourages visiting students to carry out research and development work and publish novel findings, if appropriate. It is expected that all reports and publications will follow the high standards of quality and ethical integrity that is expected of a leading research institute. In view of this, the student is required to understand and sign the following undertaking.

1. I agree that the details of the work I do for TIFR will remain confidential and will not be disclosed by me to third parties except by prior consent of TIFR.
2. I agree that intellectual property and publication rights will remain with TIFR by virtue of the fact that the project was initiated before my involvement.
3. I retain the right to write a project report and submit it to my college as required by my university for the completion of my degree provided (a) I get prior written clearance from TIFR by submitting a copy of the report in its final form to my reporting officer and (b) I properly acknowledge the intellectual inputs of others to this work.
4. I agree that TIFR has the right to publicize my project report through its web site, or by other means, provided that I am identified as the author of the report.
5. I retain the right to mention the title of this project work in my curriculum vitae.
