

Procedure to use Eduroam wireless network in Windows

Operating System Compatibility

- Windows 8 (32 bit and 64 bit).
- Windows 8.1 (32 bit and 64 bit).
- Windows 10 (32 bit and 64 bit).

Before setting up wireless for Windows 8 (32 bit & 64 bit) and Windows 8.1 (32 bit & 64 bit) follow the below procedure.

- Press “Windows Key + R” to open the Run window, type as “regedit” and click on OK.
- On the Left pane, go to
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Services\RasMan\PPP\EAP\13
- On the Right Pane, Right Click and Select New key as DWORD (32-bit) Value.
- Rename the Value as “TlsVersion” and double click to Modify Value data as “c00” and Base option as Hexadecimal.

How to connect to wireless network profile.

- Make sure that wireless button on your device is turned on.
- Click on Wireless icon present at the right bottom of your device.
- Browse for wireless network named “**eduroam**” and click on it. You will be asked to enter the credentials.
- Identity: username@tifr.res.in .
- Password: Your LDAP/roundcube password.
- Click on Connect button to connect to the wireless network.
