

Procedure to use Hostel wireless network in Windows

Note: Only TIFR hostel residents residing in Brahmagupta and Patanjali are permitted to use the wireless network. Devices used for wireless internet access in the hostel must be registered through Service Request System ([SRS](#)).

Operating System Compatibility

- Windows 8 (32 bit and 64 bit).
- Windows 8.1 (32 bit and 64 bit).
- Windows 10 (32 bit and 64 bit).

Before setting up wireless for Windows 8 (32 bit & 64 bit) and Windows 8.1 (32 bit & 64 bit) follow the below procedure.

- Press “Windows Key + R” to open the Run window, type as “regedit” and click on OK.
- On the Left pane, go to
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Services\RasMan\PPP\EAP\13
- On the Right Pane, Right Click and Select New key as DWORD (32-bit) Value.
- Rename the Value as “TlsVersion” and double click to Modify Value data as “c00” and Base option as Hexadecimal.

How to connect to wireless network profile.

- Make sure that wireless button on your device is turned on.
- Click on Wireless icon present at the right bottom of your device.
- Browse for wireless network named “**Hostel**” and click on it. You will be asked to enter the credentials.
- Enter your TIFR roundcube credentials and click OK button. Once again it will ask you to connect to the network, Click on Connect button to get connected to your network.
