Guidelines for Research Scholar at Mandala

In house Medical Facility (Medical Section)

Students can consult Institute's doctors for their health problem.

OPD hours - 9.15 am to 11.15 am & 2.15 pm. to 4.15pm.

Student should avoid calling doctors at their convenience for routine consultation.

Incase of emergencies they can visit Medical Section after OPD hours also.

Emergency treatment

In emergency, student can take treatment from the **Casualty Department of Joy Hospital** on our panel.

Reimbursement of medical expenses in emergency is restricted to case-registration charges and procedure charges at casualty department.

Whenever student takes emergency treatment after office hours or on a holiday / weekend, he/she *must* report to Institute doctors on immediate working day with all relevant documents. In case the patient is bed ridden his/her colleague *must* report.

Charges which are not permitted:

- Specialist consultation charges are not permitted.
- Medicine prescribed by casualty medical officer may be purchased for two days only. Medicines purchased for more than 2 days without the consent of medical section, will not be reimbursed.
- Medicines that are available with medical section will not be reimbursed.
- Medical expenses done without the consent of medical section will not be reimbursed.
- Vitamins & Nutritional supplement will not be reimbursed.

Specialist referral

Medical Section maintains a panel of renowned doctors from different specialties. The patients are referred to the panel doctors whenever need arises. Specialist referral is completely at the discretion of treating doctor in medical section.

If a student consults specialist as per his/her own wish charges/treatment will not be reimbursed.

At times patients do request for specialist referral for following problems

1. For seeking second opinion on patient wish
2. For cosmetic skin/hair problems
3. For routine eye check-up
4. For preexisting and chronic disorder

In such situation student will be permitted to avail the services of our panel doctors at Institutional rate but the expenses incurred will not be compensated.
